The Community Health Ambassador Program is a Lake County Health Department initiative that was created to support its goal of ensuring that **everyone who lives or works in Lake County—regardless of their zip code, race, ethnicity, age, or community—has access to the information and support they need to get vaccinated.** As a Community Health Ambassador, we hope to provide the information you need to protect yourself and our community from COVID-19.

All community members are encouraged to register for the COVID-19 vaccine through Lake County's AllVax portal.

- You will be notified when it is time to make your appointment for a COVID-19 vaccine
- The vaccine will be provided at no cost to you
- Vaccination appointments will be available at many locations in Lake County. When appointments are available, you will receive an email to schedule on the portal. The website will display locations and available times.
- Registration is quick and easy!
- Register yourself and your family at the same time
- Information needed to register: email address, full name, date of birth, zip code, risk factors
- Choose your language: English or Spanish

Protect yourself against vaccine scams! As COVID-19 vaccine distribution begins, here are signs of potential scams:

- You are asked to pay out of pocket to get the vaccine
- You are asked to pay to put your name on a vaccine waiting list or to get early access
- Advertisements for vaccines through social media platforms, email, telephone calls, online, or from unsolicited/unknown sources
- Marketers offering to sell or ship doses of the vaccine for payment
